Treasurer's Report: Crystal

Treasurer: Crystal reported that she and Mick Swope met with Margina Escobar (Orenda) earlier in the week. Our beginning balance for this year is \$7284.58.

Concession Stand Teams & Assignments:

Middle school volleyball has 3 teams, so that needs to be adjusted in concession schedule. Purchasing Chick-fil-A sandwiches for \$3 each was considered for concession sales, with a price of \$5, possibly with a meal deal of our chips and a drink for \$6, \$7 with Gatorade. The popcorn machine we have now is not the one that was used last year, is much smaller and is very dirty. It was not used for the first concession sale due to the condition of the machine. Purchasing pre-popped popcorn and transferring to smaller bags was considered. Jaimy will make a trip to purchase concessions to refill.

Concession calendar will be changed so that different grades in the same sport are responsible for concession duty. (Ex: JV Volleyball will work the Varsity game, Varsity will work the JV game.)

Equipment: Terry Pruiett reported that he spoke with a company about a trailer, and for an 8' high, 8.5' wide, 16' long trailer with sinks, generator, AC, lights, 60" window would be about \$14,500. Equipment & setup is a majority of the cost. We are looking at 5-10 years for a field house to be built with concession area. We might consider purchasing canopies with sides for concession use. Storage for canopies is a concern. In addition to trailer, there are 7 titles & registration plus food handlers licenses to be purchased. Hot dot rotisserie and popcorn machine was not included in the trailer and would still need to be purchased. Since Richard Rickey is willing to help with cost, Booster Club will present 3 options to him. 1. \$14.5K trailer (cannot be used by teams for travel for moving gear to away games) 2. Mid-priced storage only trailer (could be used by teams for moving gear) 3. Tents/canopies with logo.

Sarah Page motioned that we go ahead and spend \$400 - \$700 on a canopy with sides and logos. Jaimy seconded.

Three options will still be presented to Richard. Booster Club will also ask him about concession options in new gym.

Communications/Parliamentarian: Bekah Blanton

Bekah will contact the new members who signed up at Orientation Nights. Bekah has agreed to serve as Communications/Parliamentarian.

Spirit Wear & Gear:

Brandi Chalman showed examples of products that a company her sister works for can produce. Company is willing to give us a discount and no setup fee. Yard signs will cost \$7.50 – 15% and then we price them. One member would like to see us offer panchos. Several examples were given, such as shirts and a sheet of decals. Crystal made a motion to budget \$2000 for purchase of shirts, kuzies, hats, rally towels, and decals. Terry seconded.

Rhonda Carlin showed an example of scarves that Stony Point is selling. Board agreed that we can sell them. We will try to get preorders out by Sept. 8th on Facebooks. Preorders will help gauge how many to order. We will sell for \$20 each.

Fundraising: Nichole

Nichole would like to get the calendars out to start in January. She will get in line this month to get a spot for Poppy Festival. The booth is \$20-\$30.

Pink Out:

Volleyball's Pink Out will be October 6th. Concessions profit from that night will be donated to a breast cancer charity. Pink Out shirts will also be sold on a pre-order basis and profits from those will also be donated.
